### TWISTED CHICKEN SOUP

- Two cooked chicken breasts, shredded one thigh cooked and shredded
- 1 cup of chopped baby carrots
- 1/2 cup chopped celery
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1 can pinto beans drained
- 1 box low sodium chicken broth
- 1 can cream mushroom soup
- 1 Tablespoon crushed garlic
- 1/2 teaspoon of each of the following: dillweed, curry, sage, basil, rosemary, thyme, black pepper and one large bay leaf whole
- 1 cup medium egg noodles

Mix all ingredients into a crock pot except egg noodles. Simmer all day. Last half hour, add the noodles. Remove bay and serve piping hot with cornbread.
