#### Recipe from Diane

Granny Cake, by Roger Ann Gardner. Published in the Paducah Sun in December 1983 1 20 oz can crushed pineapple undrained 2 whole eggs 1 1/2 cups white sugar 1 Teaspoon salt 1 Teaspoon soda

2 cups plain flour

Mix all ingredients and bake in a 9 x 13 pan. Sprinkle the following topping over mixture.

Topping 1. Mix 1/2 cup brown sugar, 1 cup of chopped nuts. Sprinkle on batter. bake 35-40 minutes at 350\* ( 325\* if a glass pan)

While cake bakes prepare topping #2.

1 cup of evaporated milk.

1 stick butter

1 1/2 cups white sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Mix all ingredients and bring to a boil. Boil a minute then lower heat and simmer 10 minutes. Cool enough to allow topping to soak in cake prior to serving.


April Tech Class: Protect Yourself from Online Scams
