Families with children preparing for kindergarten are invited to a fun and educational program at the McCracken County Library.

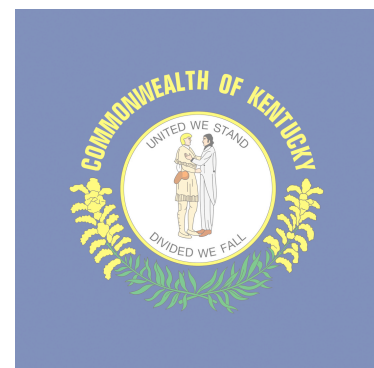
Designed for children ages 3–5 and their parents, this session focuses on building kindergarten readiness skills with a playful theme centered around apples.
